End of Week 4 Report - Sunday, February 9, 2025

Sunday, February 9th marks day 28 of the 2025 Legislative Session and policy proposals continue to be introduced by legislators. The focus of the legislature continues to be introducing new bills, holding public hearings on proposed legislation, and voting bills out of committee to move them along in the process. Both the House and Senate also spent some time on the floor this week, voting on bills and sending them over to the other chamber for further consideration. If policy bills have not been scheduled for a public hearing in the policy committee for the upcoming week, those proposals will face an uphill battle this session, with only one additional week to receive a hearing and pass out of committee – by February 21st – to remain alive this session.
