End of Week 5 Report - Sunday, February 16, 2025

Sunday, February 16 marks day 35 of the 2025 Legislative Session. Committees are still holding hearings on bills as well as scheduling bills for executive action, which is the action of voting bills out of committees to move them along in the process. Bills are continuously being amended and revised as they move through the process, which requires ongoing monitoring and review. Less than one week remains until the first legislative deadline – February 21 – where all policy bills must be voted out of their policy committee to remain *alive* this session. Bills in fiscal committees face a similar deadline a week later, on February 28.

Feb. 21 - Day 40	Policy cutoff in house of origin - last day to pass bills out of the policy committees in the chamber they were introduced
Feb. 28 - <i>Day 47</i>	Fiscal cutoff in house of origin - last day to pass bills out of fiscal committees in the chamber they were introduced
Mar. 12 - <i>Day 59</i>	House of origin cutoff - last day to pass bills out of the chamber they were introduced (House bills out of House, Senate bills out of Senate). 5pm deadline
Apr. 2 - <i>Day 80</i>	Opposite house policy cutoff – all bills from the other chamber must pass out of the policy committees
Apr. 8 - <i>Day 86</i>	Opposite house fiscal cutoff – all bills from other chamber must pass out of the fiscal committees
Apr. 16 - Day 94	Last day to pass opposite chamber bills. 5pm deadline
Apr. 27 – <i>Day 105</i>	Last day of the regular session - Sine Die!
