#### WA Recreation & Park Association Bill Status & Upcoming Events Report End of Week 2 Report – January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Week two of the session was filled with a myriad of new bill introductions, as committees continued to hold public hearings on proposed legislation. This is typical for the first few weeks of the session. Committees also continued voting bills out of committee to move them along in the process.

As a reminder, the first legislative deadline is January 31<sup>st</sup>, when all bills must pass out of their respective policy committee to remain alive. So far, there have been over 1,100 bills introduced in the 2024 session alone – that does not include bills from 2023 that also may be under consideration this session.
